## **2020 Montana Reined Cowhorse Futurity      Stallion Stakes**

1. Sires standing in the NRCHA Northwest Region are eligible to participate in the program.
2. Nomination fee will enable age-eligible offspring to enter the Stallion Stakes classes at the MRCHF Futurity or Derby for the current show year.
3. Nomination fee is \$300 paid between January 1 and April 1 of the current year. Entries will be accepted between April 2 and July 1 with a late fee of \$50. Entries close July 1.
4. Nominator/owner must also pay membership fee to MRCHF of \$25 single or \$35 family or business.
5. If a nominated stallion is three, four, or five years old, he himself is eligible to compete in the Futurity or Derby Stallion Stakes for that year.
6. Horses that were eligible by a nominated sire in a paid year under previous rules, and that sire is no longer participating, may show in the Stallion Stakes by paying the supplemental show fee of \$150 in addition to the regular entry fee.
7. A grade horse sired by a nominated sire may show in the Stallion Stakes class as long as the entry is accompanied by a DNA parentage verification and a veterinary affidavit of age.
8. Northwest Region of NRCHA includes states of Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Alaska.
9. MRCHF may deduct up to \$1500 from the total paid fees to fund the awards at the show. The total remaining funds are split 60/40% to the Futurity and Derby classes. Each division will have an Open and a Non Pro class with the purse split 60/40%.
